*Located in the centre of the ancient Cinque Port of Sandwich, the Guildhall dates back to 1579, during the reign of Queen Elizabeth I.*

*Elizabeth I's visit to Sandwich in 1563 is just one of several historic events commemorated artistically in the Court Room at the Guildhall. The Court Room, which is licensed for civil wedding ceremonies and civil partnerships, is oak-panelled throughout. With several stained glass windows and paintings dating back to the Seventeenth Century, it offers an atmospheric and unusual venue for your special day, accommodating up to sixty guests (besides the happy couple). It is also licensed for renewal of vows and baby naming ceremonies.*

*In addition, the Guildhall offers a choice of two reception rooms, as well as use of bar and kitchen facilities, so it is possible to have your ceremony and your celebration all in one location. The oak-panelled Jury Room is a picturesque venue for receptions of eighty-five to a hundred people. If you have a larger party to accommodate, the modern Main Hall can hold up to two hundred guests. We offer a discount of 10% of the hire charges for all reception rooms if both the ceremony and reception are booked at the Guildhall. We also offer a discount on the cost of hiring the Court Room for your ceremony if you are a local resident, registered on the Sandwich electoral roll.*

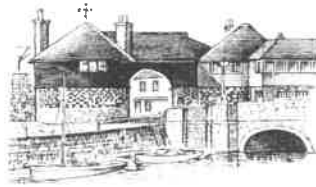

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF HIRE OF COURT ROOM, THE GUILDHALL, SANDWICH**

#### **FOR A MARRIAGE CEREMONY / CIVIL PARTNERSHIP CEREMONY**

1. As the Kent registration service allow couples to personalise their Marriage / Civil Partnership Ceremony, the Toll Bridge Fund will do all it can to arrange the room as you wish to have it. However, because of the nature of the room, it will normally be arranged as for a Court.
2. Silk flower arrangements can be provided in the Court Room, should you choose not to provide your own floral arrangements.
3. Equipment is available for playing your CD's or cassettes during the Ceremony and they must be secular only (i.e. no hymns, worship songs or other music with a religious theme). Persons booking a Ceremony in the Court Room will be responsible for ensuring compliance with Performing Rights and Phonographic Performance requirements.
4. Ushers will be required to be provided by the hirer of the Court Room if more than 20 guests are likely to be in attendance.
5. No smoking is allowed in the Court Room and no food or drink is to be consumed or confetti thrown in the room prior to or after the Marriage / Civil Partnership Ceremony.
6. Fixing of floral and other decorations: nothing shall be fixed to the walls, fixtures or fittings with pins, nails, screws or adhesive tape. Please consult the Clerk to the Trustees or Town Sergeant if you wish to decorate the Court Room.
7. Your guests will be given the opportunity to take photographs in the Court Room after your Ceremony. Please advise guests that flash lights must not be pointed directly at the paintings within the room (the paintings can be damaged by flash lights).
8. A video camera may be used in the Court Room provided the operator remains stationary and does not do anything which would constitute a distraction to the Ceremony. The operator may only stand in a position agreed with the Superintendent Registrar. No additional lighting may be used (our paintings may be damaged by certain types of lighting).

9. **Fees: Please note these do not include the charges made by the Registration Service.**

The fees payable for use of the Court Room for your Marriage Ceremony / Civil Partnership Ceremony in 2013/14 are as follows:

Monday – Friday	:	£279	
Saturday	:	£389	See below for Sandwich
Sundays/Bank Holidays	:	£441	residents reductions

For rehearsals a charge of £30 per hour or part thereof will be made (for example, a rehearsal that took one and a half hours would be subject to a fee of £60).

10. **Reduction for Sandwich residents :** A reduction of £50 on the above hire prices will be made for residents of Sandwich. Please note that the Toll Bridge Fund will only accept the name of one of the persons being married / engaging in a civil partnership on the electoral register for Sandwich.
11. **Booking deposit:** No booking shall be confirmed nor shall any agreement exist unless a booking deposit of £100 has been paid to Sandwich Toll Bridge Fund.

The balance of the booking fee and a deposit against damage / cleaning (please see below) is due 60 days prior to the date of the ceremony. In the event that the room is booked within 60 days of the ceremony, then the full amount is payable on booking.

12. **Damage / cleaning deposit :** A £50 returnable deposit will be charged against damage to the Court Room or for cleaning should confetti be thrown within the building. A separate cheque is preferred.
13. **Receptions:** Hire charges for our reception rooms are as follows:

**Main Hall (accommodates up to 200 people)**

- Main Hall: Monday to Thursday: £185.00 - Friday & Saturday: £315.00
- Use of Kitchen for Light Refreshments: £50.00
- Use of Kitchen for Hot Meals: £95.00
- Hire of Bar area: £60.00
- Preparation / Setting up on previous day: £75.00

**Jury Room (accommodates up to 100 people)**

- Jury Room: Monday to Thursday: £95.00 - Friday & Saturday: £160.00
- Use of Kitchen for Light Refreshments: £30.00
- Use of Kitchen for Hot Meals: £70.00
- Hire of Bar area: £60.00
- Preparation / Setting up on previous day: £55.00

Where the Main Hall or Jury Room are used for the reception in addition to the Marriage/ Civil Partnership Ceremony in the Court Room, a reduction equivalent to 10% of the normal hire charges will be given. The Clerk to the Trustees or Town Sergeant will be happy to arrange for you to view these rooms and assist in any way they can.

14. **Refunds** : The monies paid to Sandwich Toll Bridge Fund in respect of booking a room for a Marriage / Civil Partnership Ceremony, less 50% of the deposit, will be refunded provided at least 60 days notice is given of cancellation of the event. If less than this notice is given, then no refund will be made of the deposit. The fees retained by the Toll Bridge Fund will be to defray administration costs and loss of other potential bookings.

12. Refunds : The monies paid to Sandwich Toll Bridge Fund in respect of booking a room for a Marriage / Civil Partnership Ceremony, less 50% of the deposit, will be refunded provided at least 60 days notice is given of cancellation of the event. If less than this notice is given then no refund will be made of the deposit. The fees retained by the Toll Bridge Fund will be to defray administration costs and loss of other potential bookings.
